EAST SWALE SUNKEN VESSEL - NEW NORTH CARDINAL BUOY ESTABLISHED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a SUNKEN 50 foot converted fishing trawler is lying awash in the small craft moorings adjacent to the “Scrubbing Dock” in the East Swale. The vessel is now marked by the UPLEES NORTH CARDINAL BUOY, light characteristic is a QUICK FLASH WHITE LIGHT. In position;

51° 21.31' N 000° 52.69' E



Mariners are reminded that only the whip VHF aerial of the sunken vessel is visible at high water.

The two yellow pellet buoys previously used to mark the wreck have now been removed.
